**SPECIAL SCHOOL LEVY ELECTION PROPOSITION FATIMA SCHOOLS**

Shall the Board of Education of the Osage County R-III School District, Missouri, be authorized to increase the operating tax levy by \$0.6500 to \$4.0918 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation in order to provide funds for the construction, equipping, and furnishing of a new high school; demolition of a portion of the existing elementary school with those classrooms relocated to the new high school; to complete other repairs and improvements to the existing facilities of the District; and to meet the additional operating needs of the District?

(If this proposition is approved, the adjusted operating tax levy of the District is estimated to increase by \$0.6500 from \$3.4418, currently, to \$4.0918 per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation and can be applied to the assessed valuation in Tax Year 2023 and each year thereafter.)
